

Jetpack Harness V2 Assembly instructions



This guide is made to help you understand how to assemble your Jetpack Harness V2. Below you will find step by step photos, from receipt of box to finished Harness. You will not need any tools to complete the Harness, however you need to adjust and sew the straps to your desired length. This will be explained and illustrated as we go along. Let's begin...

Step 1 (kit received in box - overview)

- Jetpack Harness
- shoulder straps with adjustable buckle (x2)
- Straps for jetpack, with D-rings, white (x2)
- Waist belt with buckle




First step is to mount the shoulder straps. These come precut and ready to install. Take one end of the strap and wrap it around top of harness. **(pic 1)** Let it overlap by an inch (2,5 cm) approximately and sew straps together. Finished straps should look like this **(pic 2)**




STEP 2 is attaching shoulderstrap to bottom of Harness. This will be made in the same procedure as the top. But before you do that you **NEED TO ADJUST YOUR LENGTH**. This is shown in next photo. It is a good idea to get a friend to help you hold the harness in place while you measure your desired length.

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



The adjustable straps should be positioned like in photo above. Be sure not to make straps too long, as rest of strap is used for adjusting (**pic4**) If you mount these too low, it will sit in you armpit, and not be very comfortable. When both straps are attached, your harness should look like this (**pic 6**)

STEP 3 is lower part of strap, the adjusting part. First put end of strap through large D-ring on Harness, then sew flap in place like previous. (**pic 7**) When both ends are sewn onto the D-rings of the Harness, connect the ends in the adjustable buckle. (**pic 8/9**)



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When both straps are in place,
Harness should look like this. (pic 10)

STEP 4 is connecting the waist belt to the D-rings on the Harness. Again, same procedure as the shoulder straps. One end through D-ring on Harness and then sew in place.



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Once Both straps are sewn in to place it is time to adjust the waist belt. Buckle is constructed so you can move it to body's center position (**pic 12**). Strap can then be cut to length if you wish, or just leave it tugged away.

When belt buckle is adjusted to your liking, it should sit like this on you. (**pic 13**)



STEP 5 (positioning connecting straps for jetpack)


For this you should also get a helping hand. In order to make perfect alignment for your jetpack we recommend that you get someone to hold the jetpack and straps as you measure out the right position for the connecting straps (white straps with Small D-ring) The D-rings are perfect in size for hooking on to the brackets on the jetpack. These will need to be sewn in place too. Once one strap is on the pack then carefully, but firmly hold the strap along the black shouldstrap (**pic 14**) When jetpack is positioned mark with a marker, needles etc. the position and repeat other side. (**pic 15**)




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Step 6

Now that you have cut the connecting straps to your desired length it is time to get them sewn in place in the black shoulder strap. When both straps are attached it should look like this (pic 16/ 17)



The jetpack harness V2 is now finished and ready for trooping. Below are some reference photos with West and back armor on, to show how it looks when assembled and mounted.
