2 Blocks RQD

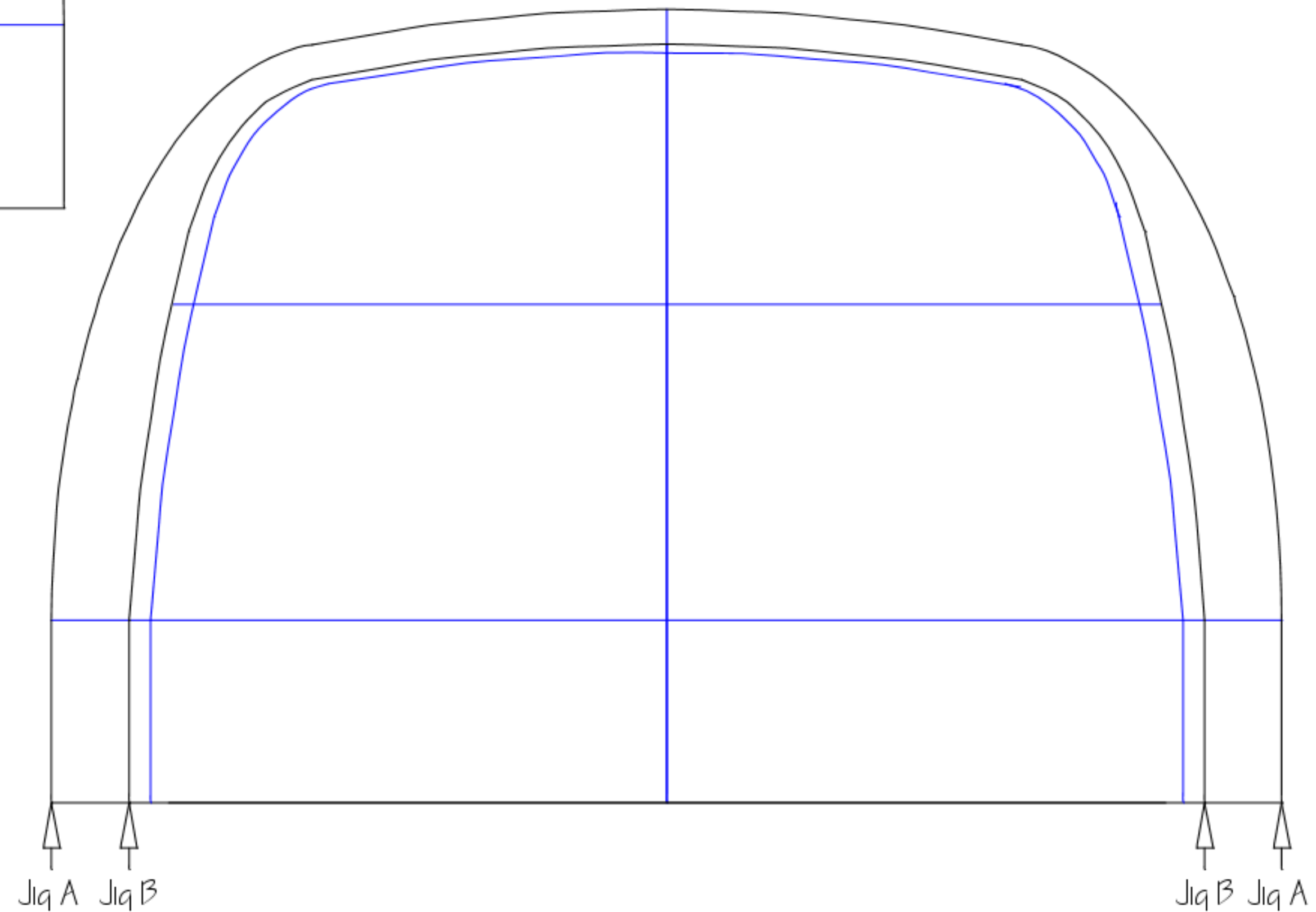
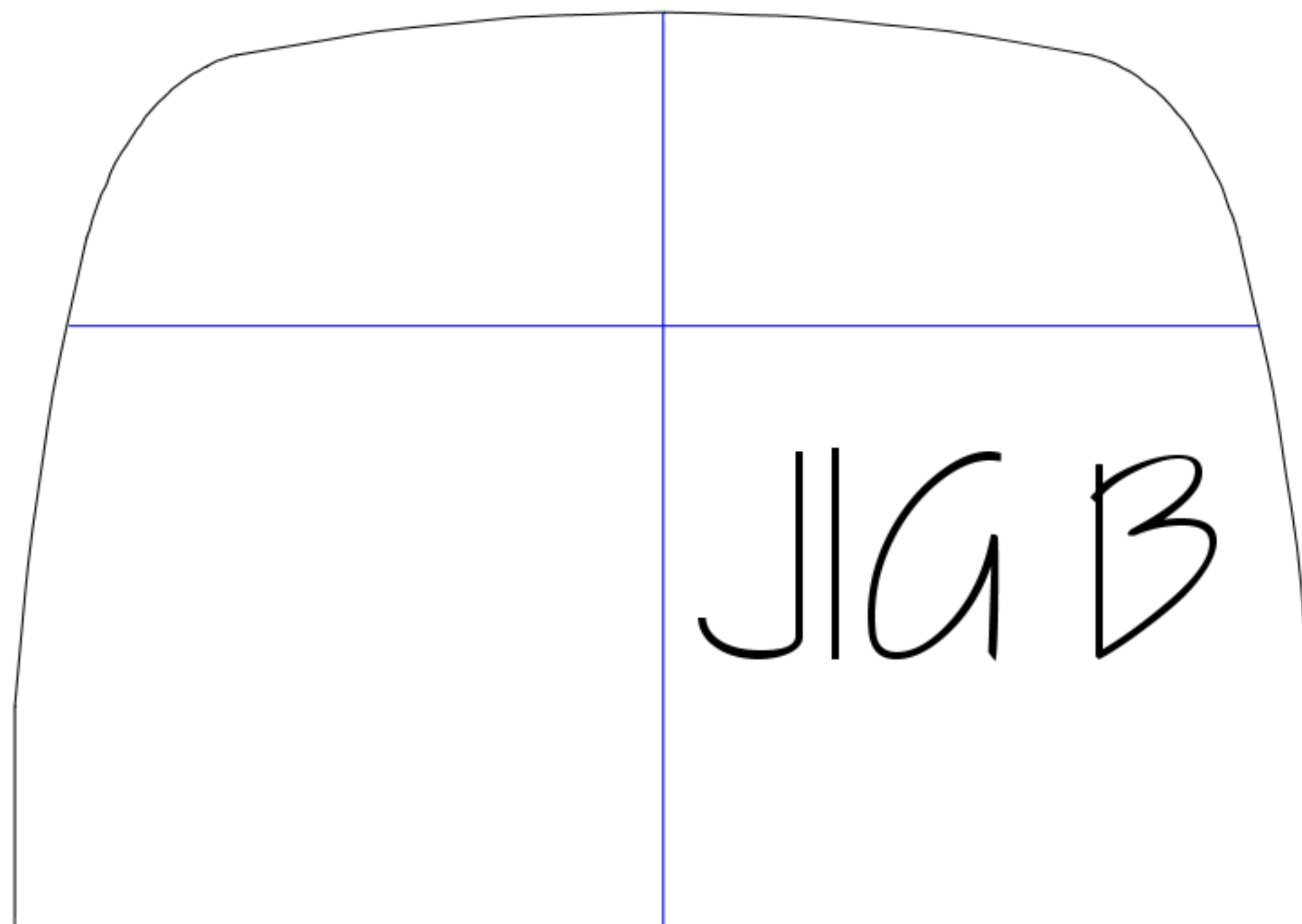




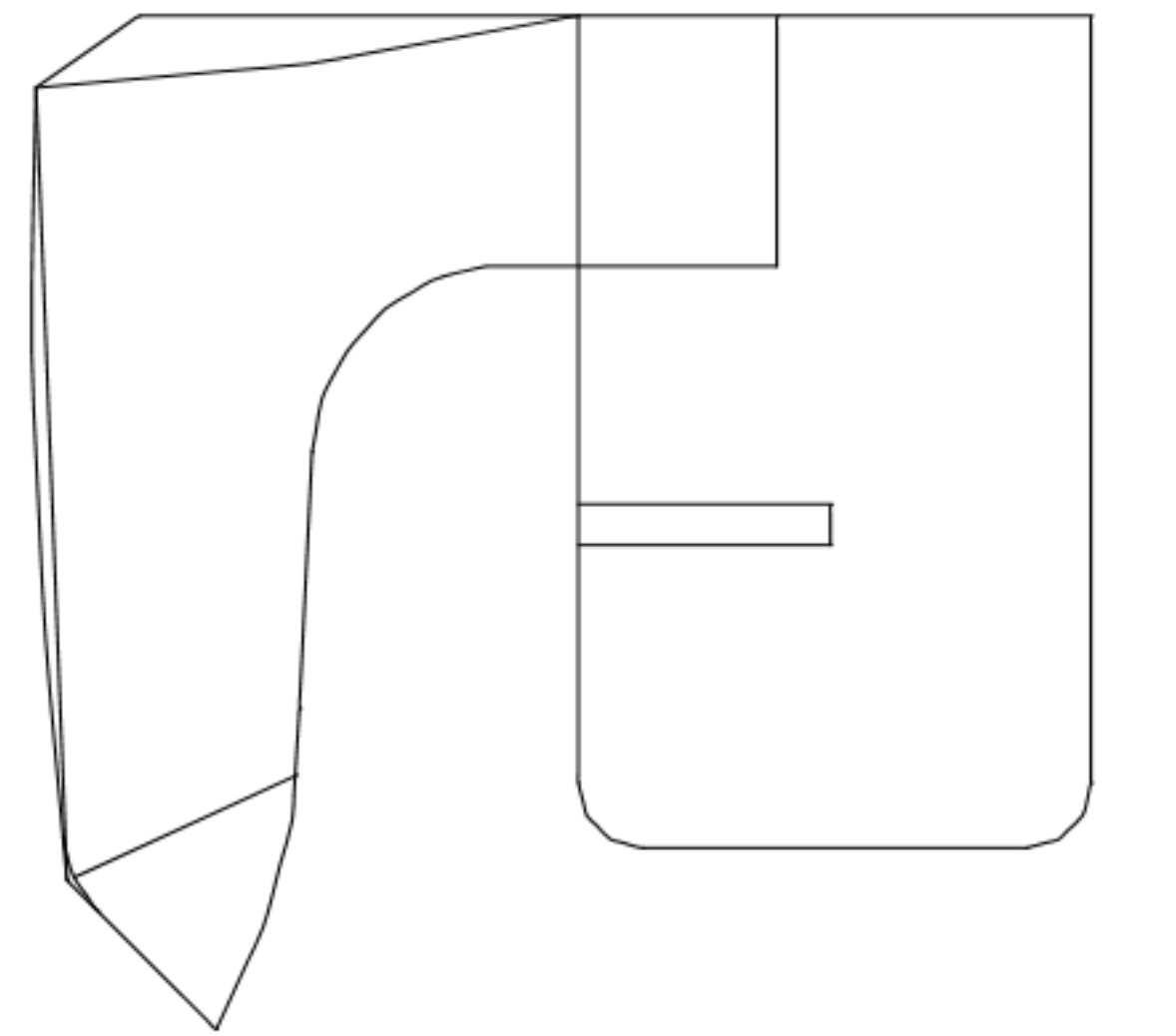
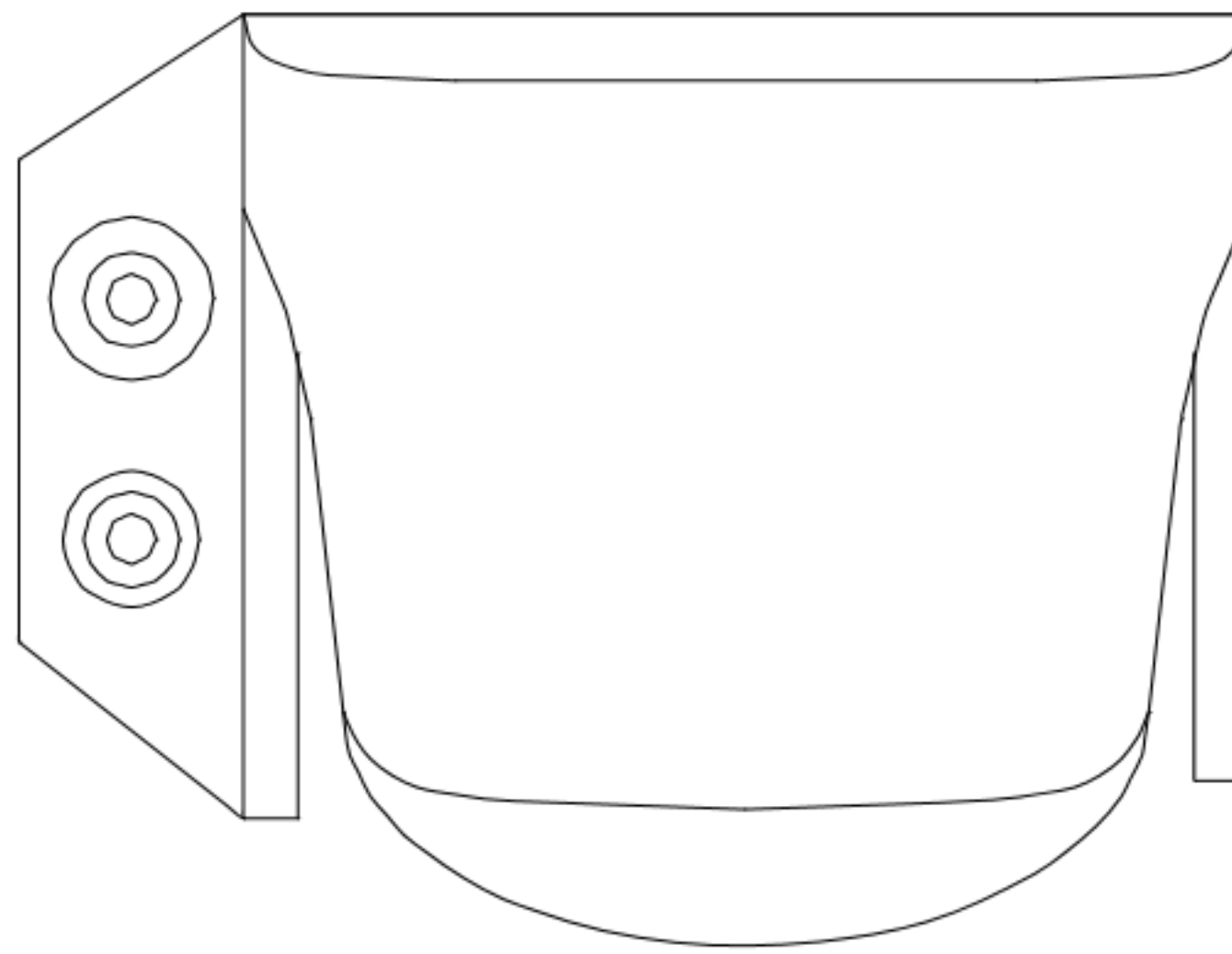
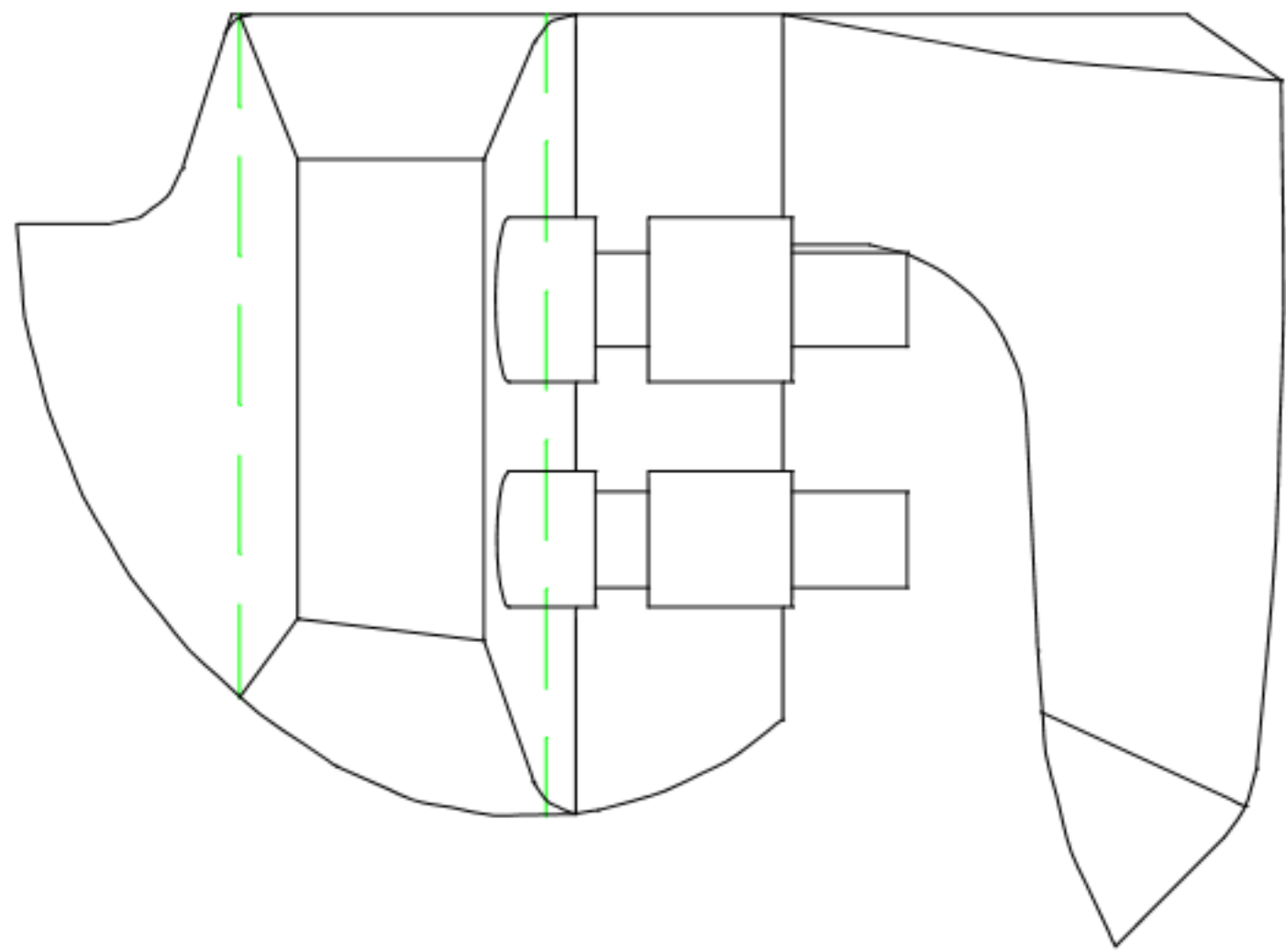
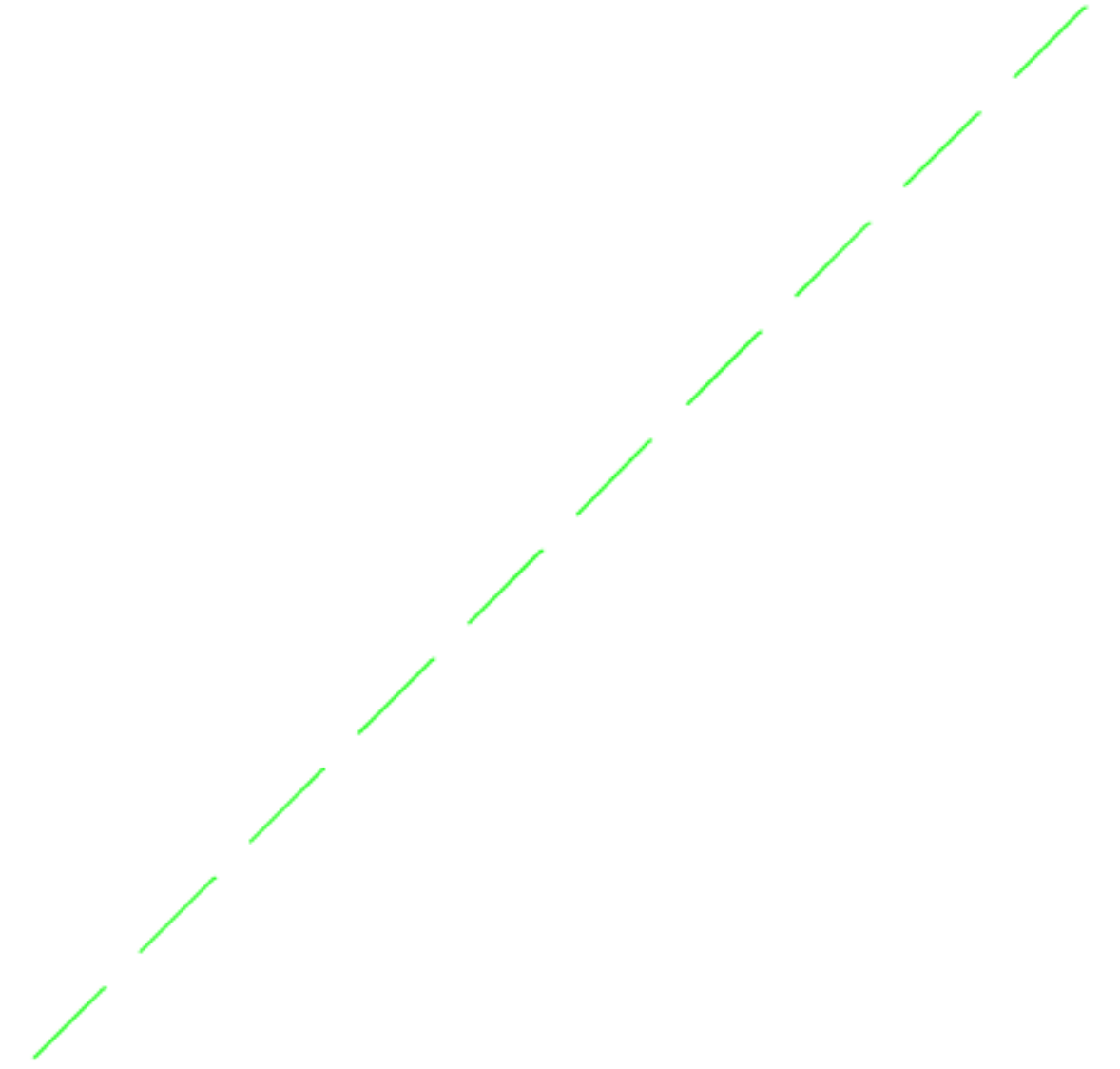
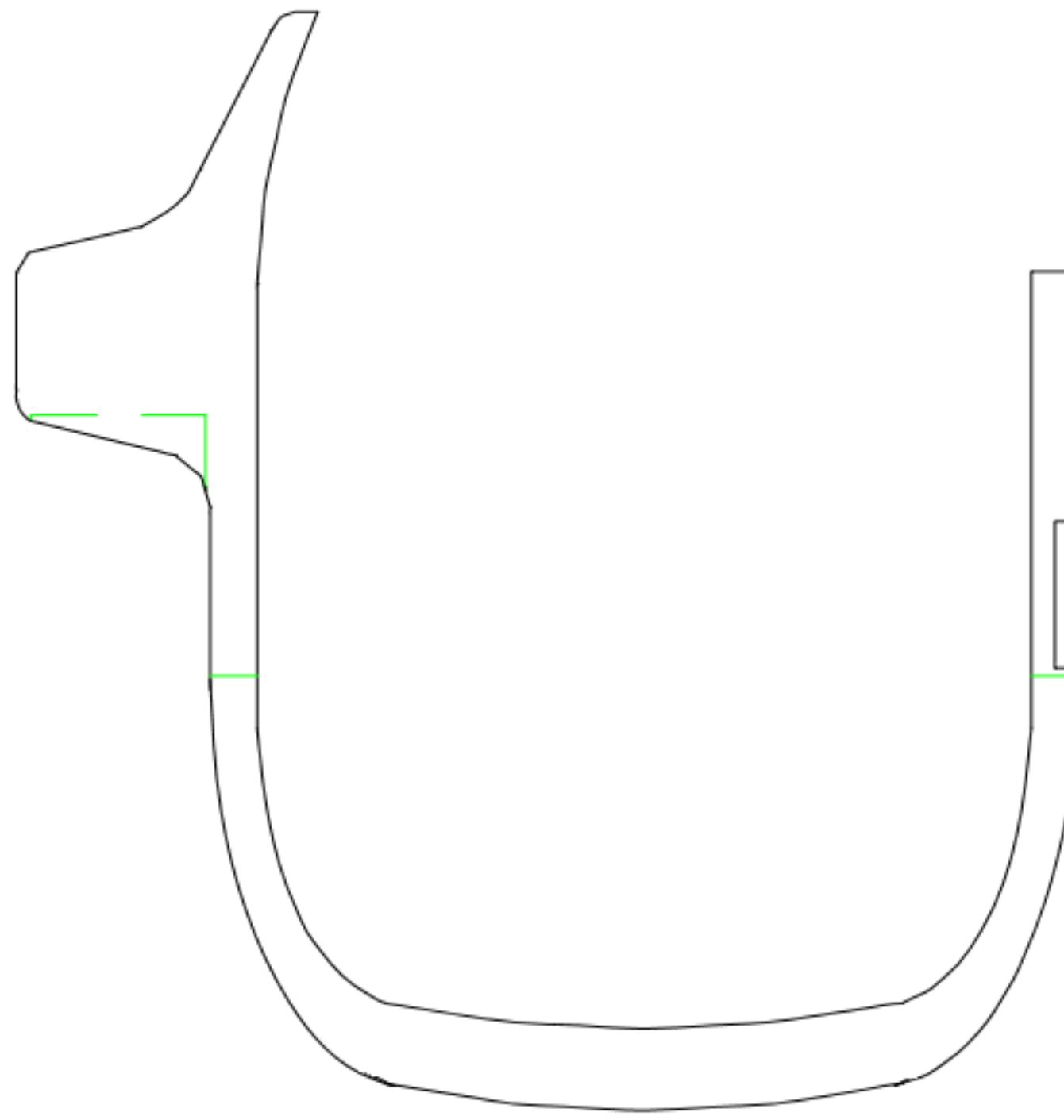
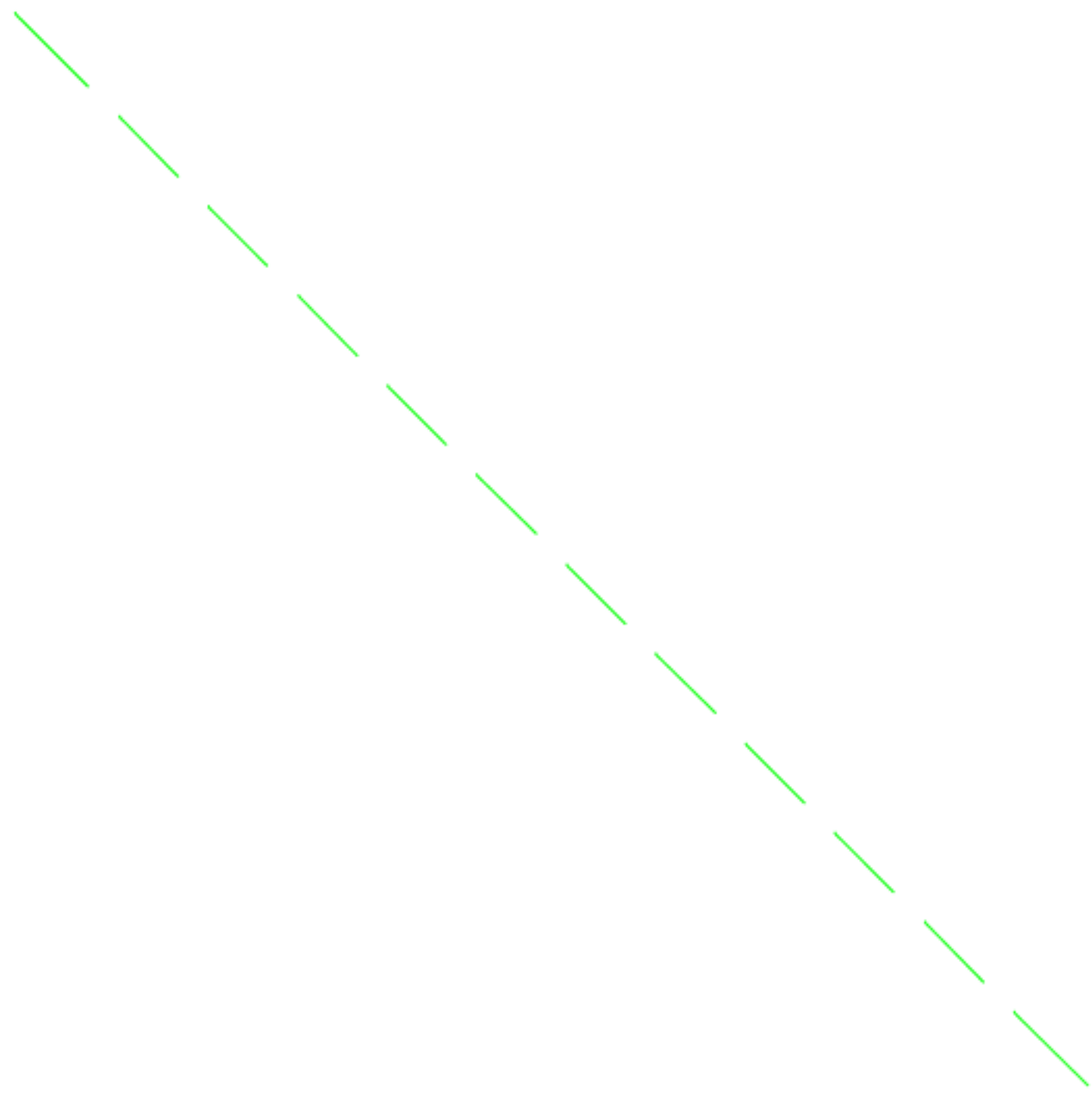
The Jig Block is made from layers of 3/4" pine glued together and sanded to shape. Once the block is ready Knee part one is heated and press against the form. A heat gun can be used to make final adjustments.

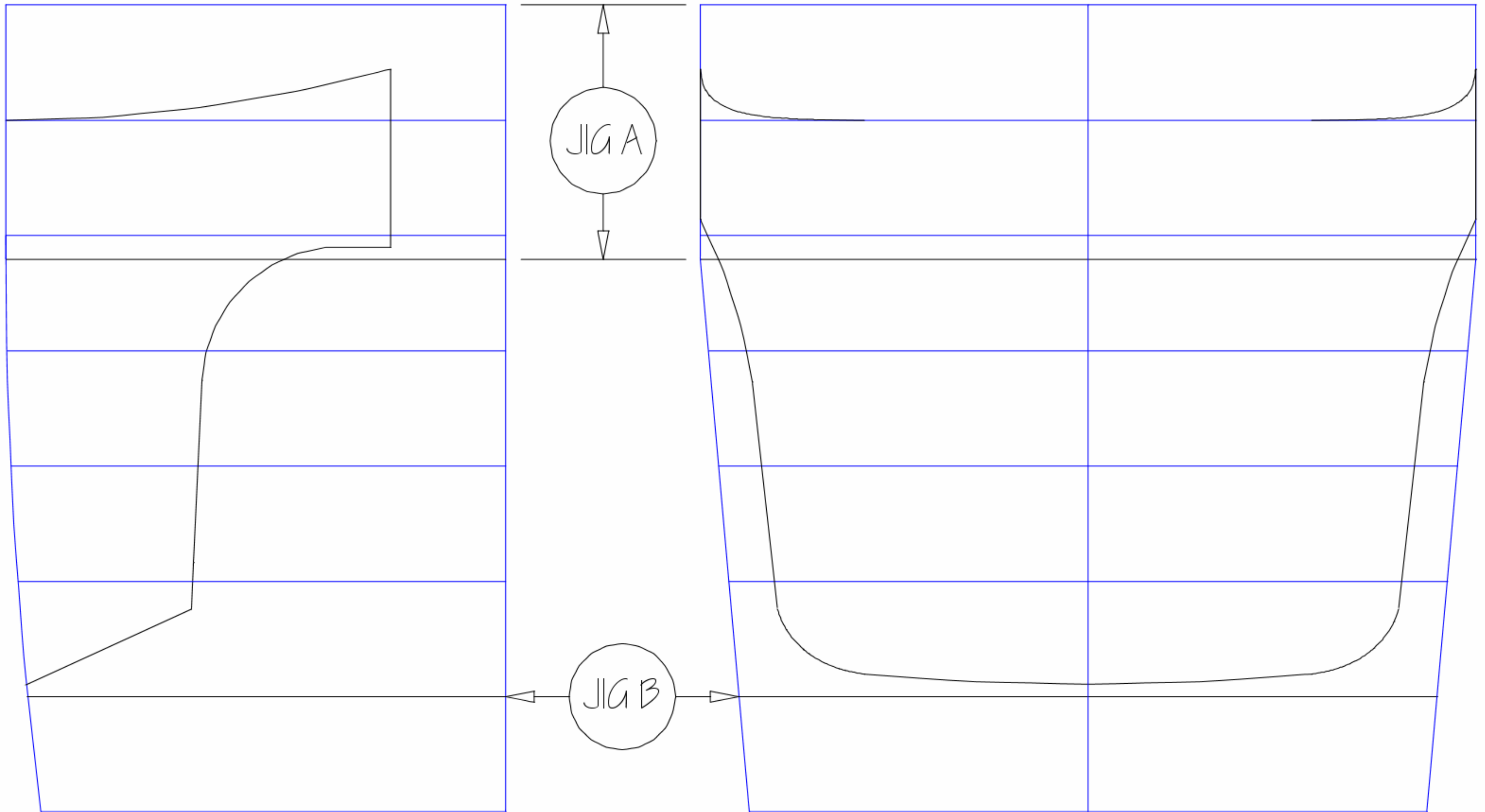
If you don't want to go to the trouble to build the Jig Block use JIG A & B as guides to hand shape Knee part #1. Cut them out of heavy cardboard and test fit them as you shape the knee. It doesn't need to be perfect.



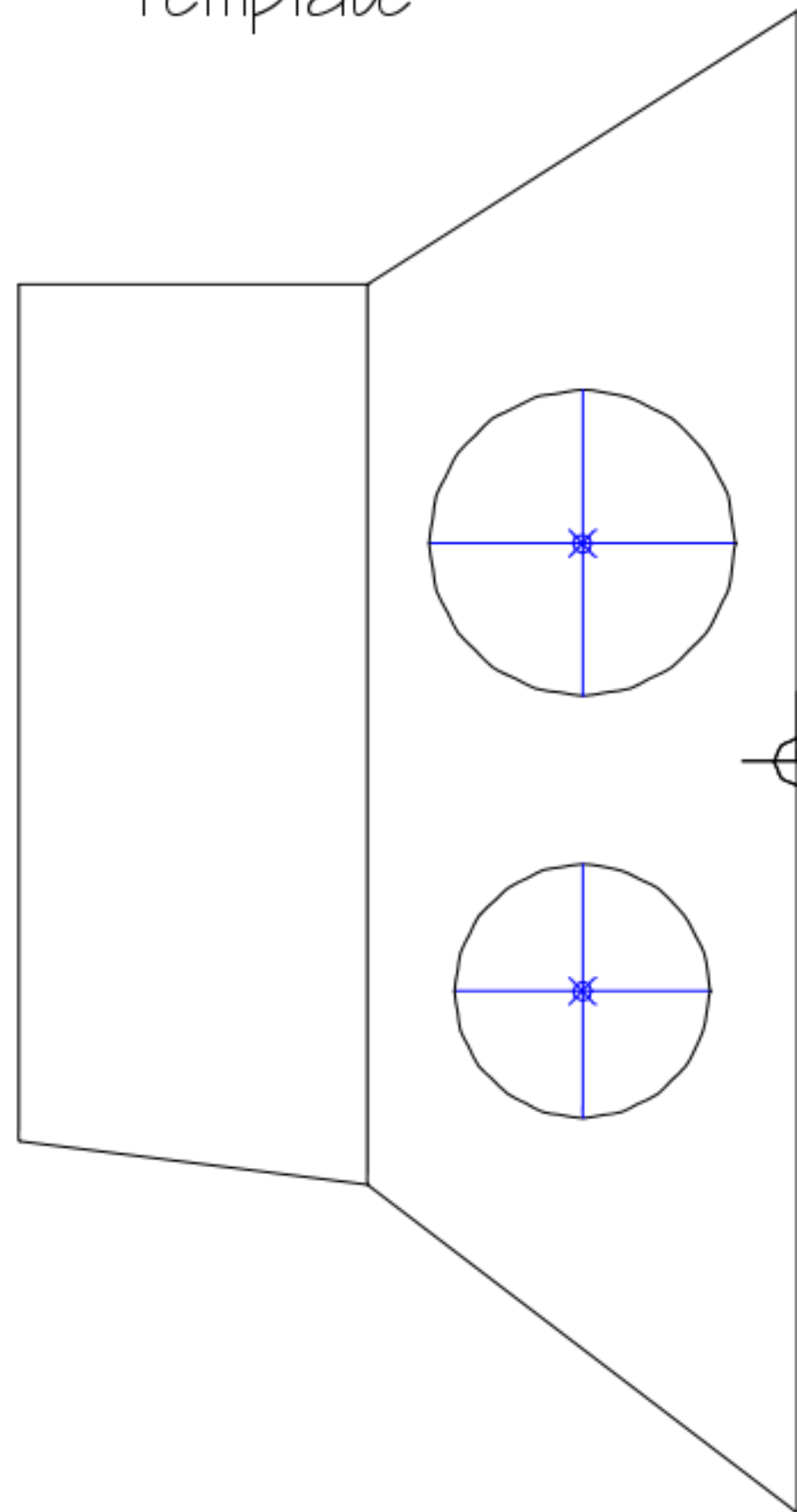
